Hollowell Church was formed in 1883. It was initially a group of brethren meeting at the home of Isaac Shank. In 1888, a meeting house was erected on the current site of our church.

Hollowell has continued to reach our community with the love of God and with the message of the Gospel by focusing on community, a deeper spiritual life through the study of Scripture and prayer, and through the power of the indwelling presence of the Holy Spirit. It is our goal to reach others, teach and obey the Word of God, and celebrate God's presence through dynamic worship.

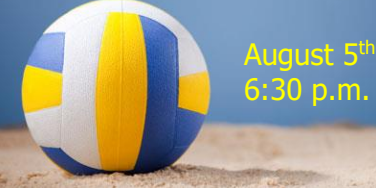

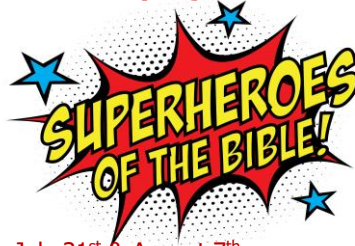

VBS Goes Viral! Wednesday nights



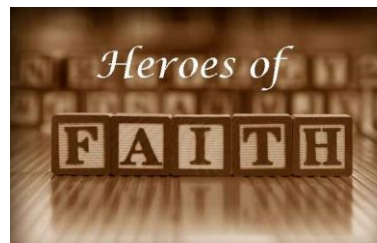
July 31st & August 7th

Kings Dominion- August 7

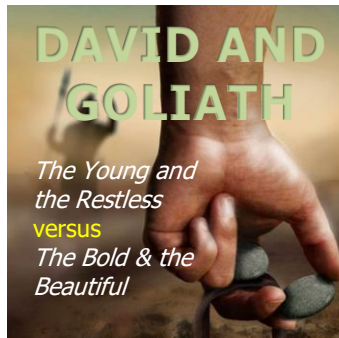
Tickets are \$40 each and available on a first come, first served basis. See Pastor Brian to sign up.
