Hollowell Church was formed in 1883. It was initially a group of brethren meeting at the home of Isaac Shank. In 1888, a meeting house was erected on the current site of our church.

Hollowell has continued to reach our community with the love of God and with the message of the Gospel by focusing on community, a deeper spiritual life through the study of Scripture and prayer, and through the power of the indwelling presence of the Holy Spirit. It is our goal to reach others, teach and obey the Word of God, and celebrate God's presence through dynamic worship.

### Locally

We currently pack for 41 students in partnership with Micah's Backpack. Students at Greencastle Antrim and both Paramount and Maugansville in Hagerstown benefit from our helping hands and support each week.

### Foreign

We are supporting the mission work of Dr. Milka in the Dominican Republic, we are providing a house mother at one of the three orphanages that we are supporting in the Dominican, and send both medical and support team missions teams to the Dominican.

We are also supporting Pastor David Joseph in India with his orphanage of roughly 120 children, a Christian school and training facility.

We are currently looking at a food pack for India much like what we did recently for the Dominican. We would like to make this one a region wide event involving other local churches and organizations as well as your family, friends and coworkers.
