PACKING LIST

- Clothing
 - Modest shirts & shorts, skirts, pants (consider warm weather)

- Dress Clothes for church 1 time – nice outfit, does not need to be very formal
- Hollowell Church T-Shirt (Will be provided to you)
- Swimwear
- Comfortable Shoes (sneakers, sandals/flip flops)
- A few simple snacks (granola bars, peanuts, etc.)

Climate Information -Temperatures are typically between 70 – 85 deg. F. in January. The relative humidity can be mild – very humid.

You are welcome to bring small items for kids. Everything must fit in your baggage. You are responsible for any baggage fees for your personal bags. If you carry a bag of supplies, the church will cover the cost of the baggage fees.

PACKING YOUR CARRY-ON (9” x 14” x 22”) *airline reserves right to put a carry-on bag in checked baggage at time of boarding.

- Pack all of your valuables (camera, laptop, money etc.) in your carry-on.
- Put all of your electronics (laptop, iPod, phone, etc.) in an easy-to-grab location, as you will have to take them out during security screening and it will be a quicker and easier process if they are in one spot, easy to grab, and easy to put away.
- Bring an empty (not a full!!!) water bottle with you if you desire.
- Bring any toiletries in a clear quart-sized Ziplock bag that’s also in an easy-to-grab location. Do not bring any liquids more than 3.4oz/ 1 quart. Do not bring any aerosol sprays.
- We recommend bringing gum (to unblock your ears), Chapstick (as plane air dries your lips out), and ear plugs (if you plan to sleep). Any medications, prescription or over-the-counter, must be in their original container or package.
- Pack a change of clothes in your carry-on, in case your checked baggage doesn’t make it at the same time you do.

THINGS NOT TO PACK IN YOUR CARRY-ON

- Liquids and toiletries, you do not need immediately (or that are bigger than the allowed size).
- Umbrellas, knives, forks, spoons, drinks, open or fresh food, needles, lighters, razors, nail clippers, scissors, aerosol sprays, etc.

THINGS TO REMEMBER

- Mosquitos in the D.R. can carry Zika, Chickaguna, Malaria, or other mosquito borne illnesses
 - Highly Recommended – Sawyer Permethrin Insect Repellent Treatment for Clothing Gear and Tents
 - Consider purchasing and taking a mosquito net
 - Insect repellent
- Minor Traveling Without Parents – Minors may be able to travel to another country without either one of their parents. We ask for a notarized written consent letter from both parents. If this applies to you, please let us know.
- Medications and Vaccines – go to <https://wwwnc.cdc.gov/travel> - Select Dominican Republic and read information on suggested Medications and Vaccines.
 - All Travelers – Routine Vaccinations (i.e. Tetanus)
 - Most Travelers – Hepatitis A and Typhoid Vaccines
 - Most Travelers – Hepatitis B and Malaria Vaccines/Medications
 - Will monitor any recommendations for COVID-19.
