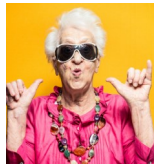

Hollowell Church Return to Worship Guidelines

- Everyone will park either by the Main entrance or the kitchen entrance to enter the building
- Face Coverings must be worn until you have been seated as a family or individual
- Tithes and Offerings are to be placed in one of the collection boxes located in the lobby or worship center prior to the message. You can also mail to the church directly or utilize the online giving platform
- Anyone moving throughout the worship center is required to have a face covering
- We will be seated during worship. Anyone desiring to stand to worship must wear a face covering
- Extra Face Coverings and Hand Sanitizer will be available
- Everyone is encouraged to bring their own drink
- After the worship service has finished face coverings must be worn until you have exited the building
- At this time social interactions must take place outside of the building between individuals and/or families
- The Nursery will be opened but **not staffed**. Please continue to wear a mask and practice social distancing.
